When responding to the survey, if your household doesn't need any special assistance, think about any neighbors who might. The plan is based on the concept of "Neighbor helping Neighbor".

Many people are quick to think that they have nothing to offer, but all kinds of equipment, supplies, and skills can be useful. For example, camping gear, tools and construction materials will help make temporary shelters. Office skills are useful at the Command Center to help keep track of people and pets in the shelter area. Think creatively and feel free to contact the person who gave you this form to discuss any thoughts.

Information requested in this survey is voluntary and will be used to tailor the neighborhood support concept to the Mount Washington-Jessica area, and will be used solely to develop and execute the emergency plan. Personal information will be maintained and controlled by the Neighborhood Disaster Preparedness Team and used only in the event of an actual emergency.
