- There will be no parking in the church lot for day of event, we will need it for emergency vehicles. The triage and pet care will be held in the church lot.

- Discussed having stuffed animals for part of the pet rescue team.
- Working to have the fire department to come and be a part of the drill.

• At the end of the drill we will have the "Hot Wash" where all participants fill out a questionnaire about their experience. Evaluators will let us know what we did right/wrong and how we can improve in case of a real emergency. A great learning opportunity for all.
